

# **2019 DUES**

Club 2019 dues were due as of January 1, 2019. If you fly at Rocky Top Field on or after January 1, 2019 you will need a current (2019) AMA card.

If you are going to renew you Club membership at the April meeting, bring your 2019 AMA card. If you are paying by check, make the check out to "Tri-Lakes R/C Flying Club. You may also pay your dues in cash.

The dues schedule is as follows:

1. FULL MEMBERSHIP - \$80 per year.

2. ADDITIONAL FAMILY MEMBERS - \$5 each per year.

3. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP (non- voting) - \$15 per year.

4. STUDENTS - Free Club membership but must be a current AMA member.

If you joined the Club during 2018 talk to the Treasurer before paying as you may get a discount on your 2019 dues.
