TRI-LAKES RC FLYING CLUB FEBRUARY 14, 2012

Vice-President Gene Fuson opened the meeting at 6:01 PM, at The Coachlight Village Clubhouse. All Officers were present except President Jim Haney. There were 9 members present including the Officers. Greg Moody was a guest. Greg was a Club member several years ago and said he intended to get back into R/C. Roy Steinestel won the 50/50 split the pot. He received \$4 of the \$8 pot.

Committee Reports: Treasurer Roy Steinestel reported that there was \$2,135.55 in the bank as of February 1st.

The minutes of the January meeting were approved as printed in the February Newsletter.

Old Business: Roy Steinestel said he had gotten our checking account squared away and the bank now has the needed info on the new Club officers for 2012.

John Woods reported on the R/C class that he and Don Johnson presented to the CAP on February 9th. There were 29 CAP members, cadets and family in attendance. The class seemed to be well received. Another class will be held March 8th plus a demo class at our field in April.

Bud Austin reported on meeting with the Branson Girls and Boys Club. It seems the Branson club had some RTF's but they had been destroyed. There is an indoor site available but that would be hard to teach RC flying in and there is no outdoor site close by. John Woods suggested that we have one ground school class with buddy-box flying at our field as an alternative. Bud will meet again with the Boys and Girls club and see if this is doable or if they

have any other ideas.

New Business: John Woods suggested that the Club's free student membership be restricted to students of 19 years or younger.

Program: Erv Rohde showed off the new Club trainer. The plane was originally built by former Club member Dick Dale, who gave it to Chuck Stone, who in turn donated it to the Club. Erv added a motor mount, Saito 72 4 stroke engine with 12 x 8 prop, channel 39 receiver, transmitter, flight battery, fuel tank, etc. The trainer has a 72.5 inch wing span and weighs 8.6 pounds including a lot of nose weight for balance. Erv only asks that if or when the trainer is demolished, that the motor and radio gear be returned to him. Very generous, Erv.

Jim Halbert showed and demonstrated a blast gate he had developed for handling dust collection in his woodworking shop. You can see a demo by going to Google and typing in youtube jim halbert blast gate. You'll also see a few views of his shop in the video.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:58 PM.
