
Got an email from President John, along with his column and a few photos. Said they would probably be back by the March meeting. He also complained about how cold it was in Florida, auwwwww.

Time to land for this month.....ed.










Don's Polaris XL coming in for a landing on the snow.

SAFETY FIRST

Hopefully we will start to see some warmer weather soon, weather that will be conducive to flying once again. I know some of you have been out to the field in marginal weather, but the older I get, the colder I get.

Before venturing out to fly once again, please take the time to check out your airplanes for safety reasons. Check those motor mounts, loose screws and bolts, electrical connections, propellers, etc. Repair any damage that has been done to the airframe, and do a range check if it has been awhile.

Do this not only for safety reasons, but for your own confidence. Getting to the field with an airplane that doesn't work properly, a motor that won't run, or having to do repairs before you get in the air is not fun, it is down right frustrating. Things will go a lot smoother if you prepare at home, then go to the field and just have fun flying.
